TASK (1): Pick-up Brush along Driveway

EQUIPMENT: Having a truck would make this a lot easier. Gloves and safety glasses would be nice to have so bring your own or we can loan you a pair.

NOTE: There is a lot of “pre-cut” brush on the ground. If you want to bring a brush cutter and do additional “trimming” that would work also. We will make arrangements for a place to dump the brush.

TASK (2): Pick-up Brush in back of Club House

EQUIPMENT: Having a truck would make this a lot easier. Gloves and safety glasses would be nice to have so bring your own or we can loan you a pair.

NOTE: There is a lot of “pre-cut” brush on the ground. If you want to bring a brush cutter and do additional “trimming” that would work also. We will make arrangements for a place to dump the brush

TASK (3): Pick-up Brush along Road to Ranges

TASK (4): Paint Club House Exterior Window Frames

EQUIPMENT: Club will provide primer, paint caulking and brush(s), ladders.

NOTE: Window frames will have to be scraped, primed and painted.

TASK (5): Pick-up “trash” along driveway

EQUIPMENT: Club will provide gloves and trash barrels

NOTE: there is a bunch of beer/soda cans, bottles, etc. along the driveway. Most of it is on the Pond side of the driveway and within 10-20 feet of the driveway.

TASK (6): Paint Fascia trim on Rifle/Pistol Shack

EQUIPMENT: Club will provide paint & brushes

NOTE: Sections of the roof fascia boards have been replaced and primed but no finish coat of paint. So, both the new boards and the “old” boards need painting. You will need something like a 8’ ladder and/or step ladder.

TASK (7): Paint Fascia trim on outdoor Mens/Ladies Rest Room

EQUIPMENT: Club will provide paint & brushes
